

The Ashippun Planning Commission was called to order by Vice-Chairman Bob Guenther on Thursday, March 2, 2017 at 7:30 pm. Members present were Bob Guenther, Peter Klug, Jim Koepke, Judy Swanton, Syl Hoerth and Secretary Heidi Tunak. Absent David Guckenberger and Jeni Norton.

Motion by Hoerth, seconded by Swanton to approve the February minutes as printed. All in favor, motion carried.

Lester Schuett, N802 State Rd 67, PIN# 002-0917-3011-048, final approval of CSM, was on the agenda but not in attendance. Will be held over to the April meeting when Schuett or a representative can be in attendance.

Steve Rublee, agent for Margaret Van Beckum, was on the agenda but not in attendance for discussion and final approval for land split on Filmore Rd, minor land split between PIN# 002-0917-1111-000 and PIN# 002-0917-1112-000 in order to create one lot combining PIN# 002-0917-1112-000 with PIN# 002-0917-1113-000 for a total of 62 acres. Guenther said the deed transfer notice was in the Watertown Daily Times. Will be held over to the April meeting.

Possible future agenda items – Discussion on minimum building standards and tiny homes; review of future land use map changes so MSA can begin working on updates.

Klug motioned and Swanton seconded to adjourn at 7:46 pm.
