

Ashippun Town Board Meeting
November 17, 2016

Chairman Steve Panozzo called the monthly Town of Ashippun board meeting to order on Thursday, November 17, 2016 at 7:00 pm at the Ashippun Town Hall. Pledge to the flag was recited.

Clerk Michelle Liesener verified the meeting notices were properly given and posted at the Town Hall, the Recycling Center, the Ashippun Post Office, emailed to the Watertown Daily Times, the Oconomowoc Focus, WTTN radio stations and posted on the official website of the Town of Ashippun.

Roll call was taken with Chairman Steve Panozzo, Supervisor Norman Greeb, Supervisor William Bremer, Supervisor David Adkins, Supervisor James Meyer and Clerk/Treasurer Michelle Liesener as being present. Supervisor Meyer moved and Supervisor Greeb seconded to approve the October 13, 2016 meeting minutes. All in favor and motion carried.

Public Input: Tom Jordens thanked Clerk Liesener on a well run election.

Police Report: Chairman Panozzo read the October police report.

Fire Department Report: Supervisor Meyer reported 4 fire calls and 8 EMS calls in October.

Clerk/Treasurer's report and presentation of bills. Clerk Liesener gave the Treasurer's report for October. Deposits, disbursements, and interest for the month were reported. Supervisor Meyer moved and Supervisor Bremer seconded to approve the October Treasurer's report. All in favor and motion carried. Supervisor Adkins moved and Supervisor Bremer seconded to approve the November bills to be paid. All in favor and motion carried. Discussed 5 checks.

Building Inspector's Report: No report available.

Highway Department Report: Highway Supervisor Dan Vander Molen has nothing new to report.

Town Chairman/Supervisors Reports: Supervisor Meyer stated the Town Ordinances need to be looked at for updates. Supervisor Adkins thanked Clerk Liesener for a well organized election. Supervisor Bremer thanked Clerk Liesener for an excellent election. Chairman Panozzo thanked Clerk Liesener for a well run election.

Unfinished Business: Discussion only on possible future road work on Harding Road. Nothing new to discuss.

New Business: David Guckenberger presented on a Conditional Use Permit for Stone Bank Sportsmen's Club. Supervisor Meyer moved and Supervisor Adkins seconded to recommend the Conditional Use Permit for Stone Bank Sportsmen's Club, to allow the filling and grading of more than 2,000 square feet within 300 feet of a navigable waterway associated with the construction of a proposed shed at W1552 O'Neil Road. All in favor and motion carried. Supervisor Meyer moved and Supervisor Bremer seconded to hold over to the December Town Board Meeting the possible approval of the City of Oconomowoc Ambulance Service Contract for 2017. All in favor and motion carried. Chairman Panozzo moved and Supervisor Adkins seconded to approve New Operator's Licenses through June 30, 2017 for Derek S. Milbrath, Station 67 and Kelly S. Orlowski, O'Tee's. All in favor and motion carried.

Town Chairman/Supervisors correspondence: Clerk Liesener read a letter the Town received from Antonio Narvaez. Supervisor Meyer felt Antonio Narvaez should have attended the Town Board meeting to read the letter himself if he wanted the letter be read for the record. Supervisor Bremer took offense to the letter from Antonio Narvaez. He stated Antonio Narvaez started the process before permits were obtained, he lied about the use and changed his application as he was presenting it. Supervisor Bremer felt the letter was only Antonio's opinion. Supervisor Bremer would like the request from the History Committee asking to use the Town Hall and grounds for their Indian Summer in 2017 put on the December agenda. Chairman Panozzo stated the December agenda will also include discussion on possible changes to the Recycling Center.

Public Input: David Guckenberger said he will take some ownership to some of the issues in the letter from Antonio Narvaez. The Planning Commission members are not solution planners. The Planning Commission nor the Town Board members are experts on zoning as the Town is under County zoning. The Planning Commission members do the best they can on behalf of the Town. Terry Norton stated he is impressed with the maintenance of the

cemeteries the Town is responsible for maintaining. Mitch Hertneky announced the Ashippun Business Association will be hosting tree lighting and Santa visit on December 4, 2016 at 6:00 pm by the Ashippun Fire Station.

Announcements: Chairman Panozzo reviewed the calendar items. Plan Commission meeting on December 1, 2016 at 7:30 pm. Town Board meeting on December 8, 2016 at 7:00 pm. Chairman Panozzo moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:36 pm. Supervisor Meyer seconded the motion. All in favor. Meeting adjourned.
