

Ashippun Town Board Meeting

July 21, 2016

Chairman Steve Panozzo called the monthly Town of Ashippun board meeting to order on Thursday, July 21, 2016 at 7:00 pm at the Ashippun Town Hall. Pledge to the flag was recited. Chairman Panozzo Said a few words about past Chairman Ernie Borchardt who recently passed away.

Clerk Michelle Liesener verified the meeting notices were properly given and posted at the Town Hall, the Recycling Center, the Ashippun Post Office, emailed to the Watertown Daily Times, the Oconomowoc Focus, WTTN radio stations and posted on the official website of the Town of Ashippun.

Roll call was taken with Chairman Steve Panozzo, Supervisor Norman Greeb, Supervisor William Bremer, Supervisor David Adkins, Supervisor James Meyer and Clerk/Treasurer Michelle Liesener as being present. Supervisor Adkins moved and Supervisor Bremer seconded to approve the June 9, 2016 meeting minutes. All in favor and motion carried.

Public Input: Syl Hoerth asked about the schedule for roadside cutting the remainder of the season. He also asked about a town weed commissioner.

Police Report: Officer Johnson gave the June police report.

Fire Department Report: No report available.

Clerk/Treasurer's report and presentation of bills. Clerk Liesener gave the Treasurer's report for June. Deposits, disbursements, and interest for the month were reported. Chairman Panozzo moved and Supervisor Bremer seconded to approve the June Treasurer's report. All in favor and motion carried. Chairman Panozzo moved and Supervisor Adkins seconded to approve the July bills to be paid. All in favor and motion carried.

Building Inspector's Report: Chairman Panozzo read the May and June building reports.

Highway Department Report: Highway Supervisor Dan Vander Molen was not able to attend the meeting due to a tree being down from this evenings storm. The Norwegian culvert project is almost complete, the asphalt is scheduled to be done the first part of August.

New Business: Supervisor Meyer moved and Supervisor Bremer seconded to have the Chairman sign the Election Voting Equipment Agreement. All in favor and motion carried.

Chairman Panozzo moved and Supervisor Meyer seconded to approve New Operator's License for Amber L. McDowell, Olivia M. Radtke, Abigail C. Monis for Deertrak, Stephanie L. Annen for Trackside and Jessica L. Edwards for Station 67 through June 30, 2017. All in favor and motion carried.

Chairman Panozzo read an email from Dodge County Highway Assistant Commissioner Pete Thompson. "After review of the intersection, our department will be installing a set of 3 rumble strips on CTH O in both directions approaching CTH P". Discussion followed.

Public Input: Mitch Hertneky asked if the drainage problem on Heather/Amanda Streets and Roosevelt/Center Streets is still on the schedule to be started after the Norwegian culvert project has been completed.
